
Inside Out Box

Go to your kitchen and find a cardboard box. Yes, a box with something in it. Take that out, but don't make a mess, and I will walk you through the steps to turn the box inside out, and rename the product to something different. Just wait, it'll be amazing.



Dry goods are best to dismantle and reassemble. I have tea, a webcam box and coffee filters. No mess!



Find the first lip or tab. Gently peel that back. Depending on how old the box will determine the strength of the glue. Be gentle – DO NOT TEAR!








Slow and deliberate action. The tabs must maintain integrity because we will use them to repackage the package.







I'm using transparent tape for my re-build. You may use a heavier tape. If so, have a scissors handy to cut.






The vertical tab goes first. I used two 4" tape strands. Use what you feel is right to you.



A couple strands of tape here too.






Depending on the box, you may have to slide your hand inside to create pressure on your **bottom folds of your** box. This will create a stronger hold for your **Inside Out Box.**
